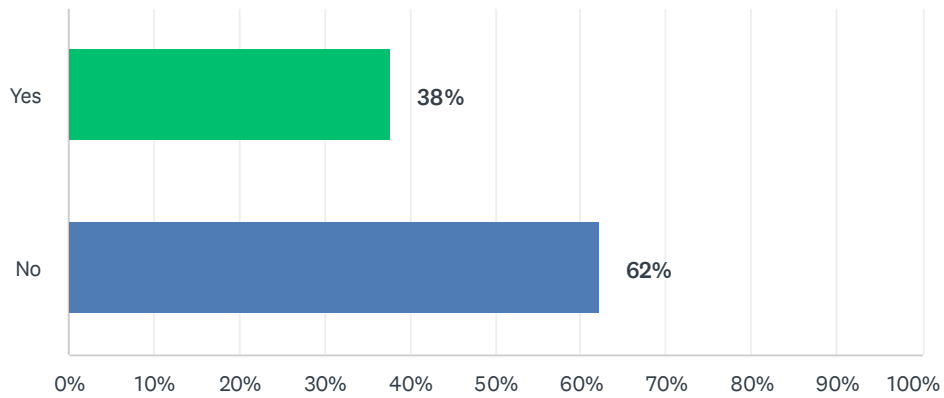

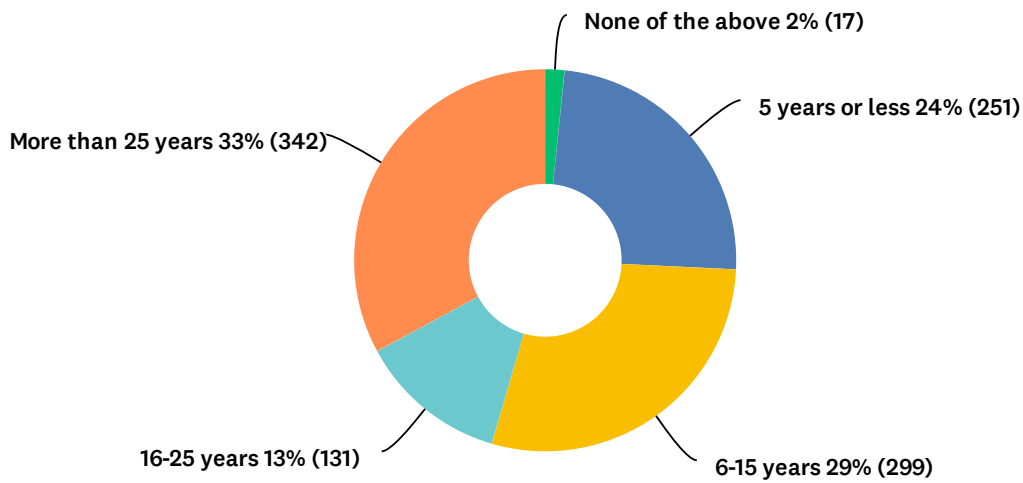

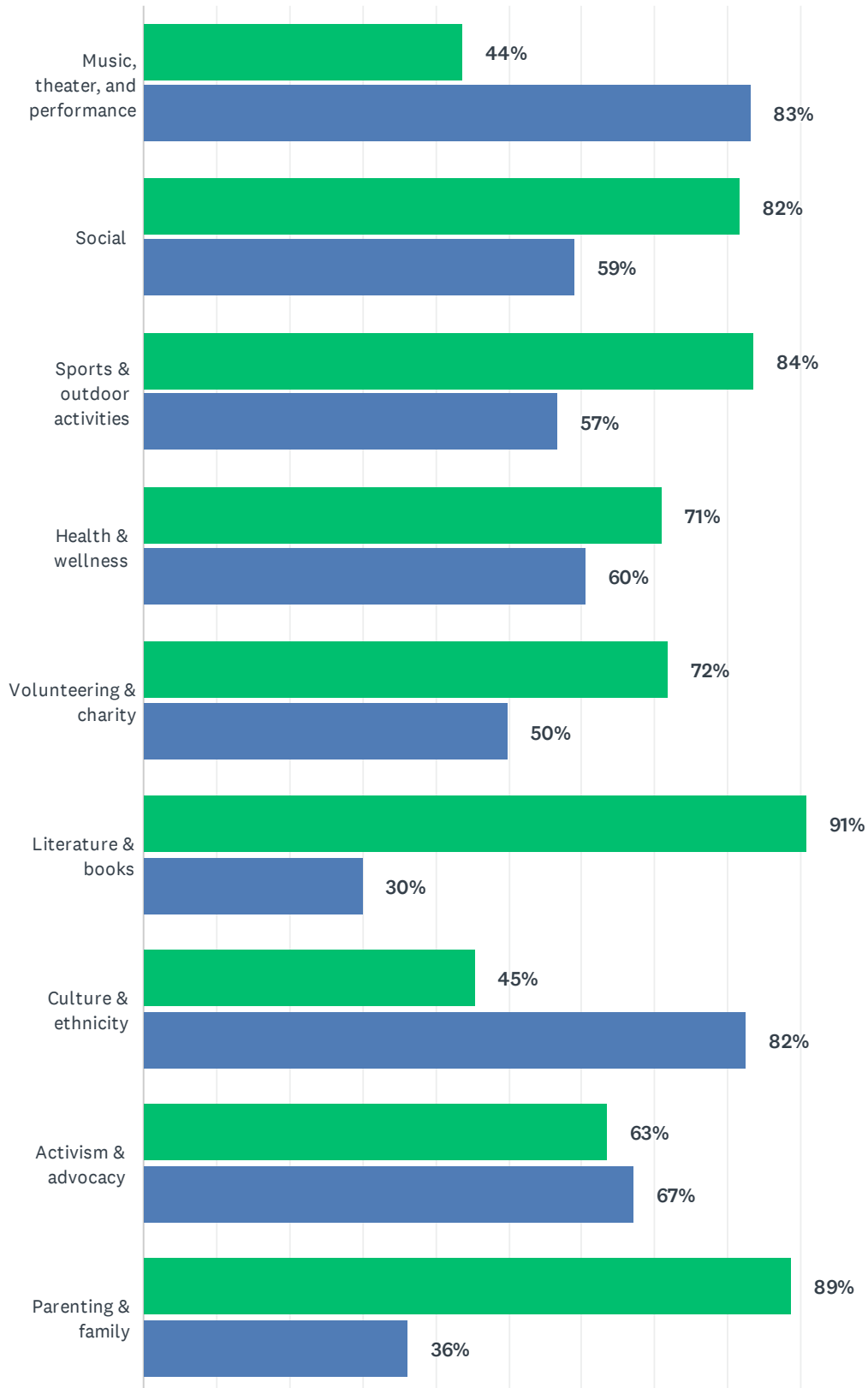

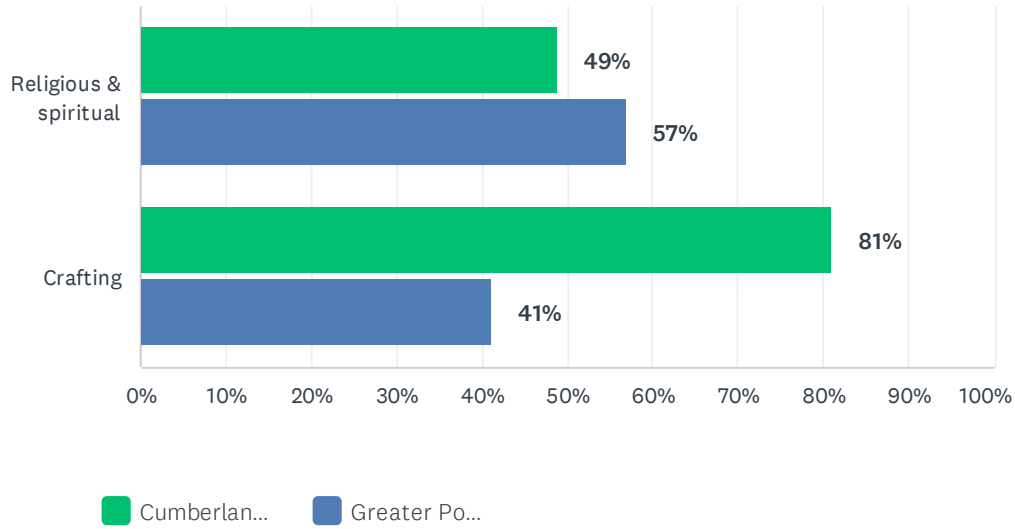

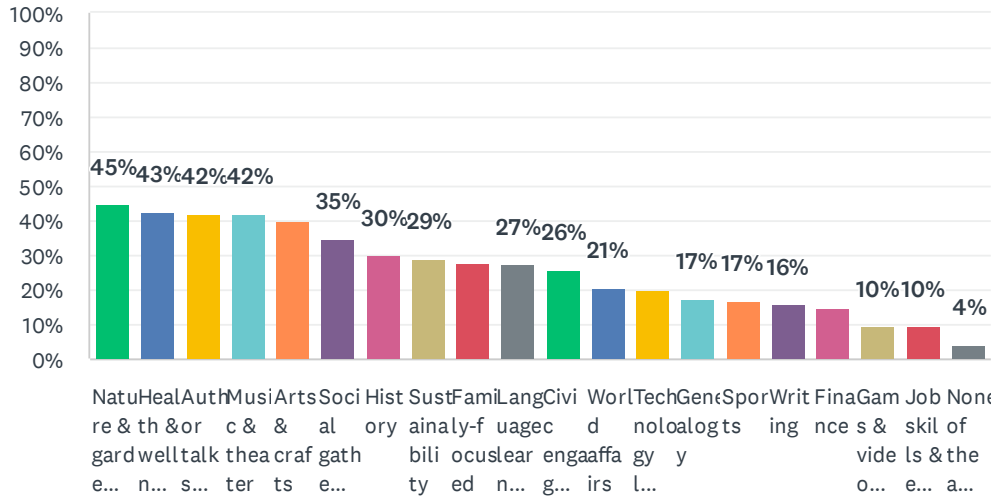

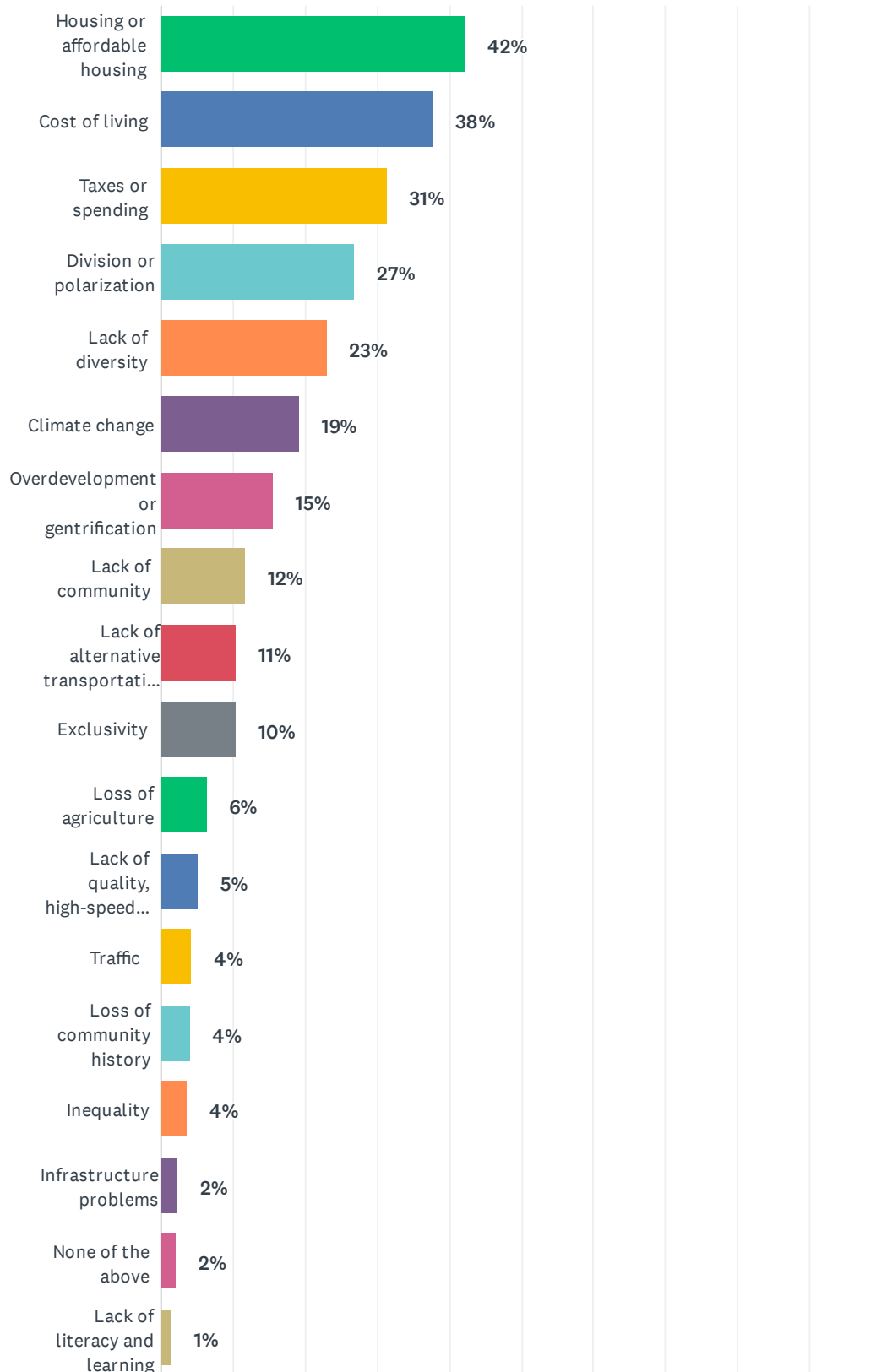

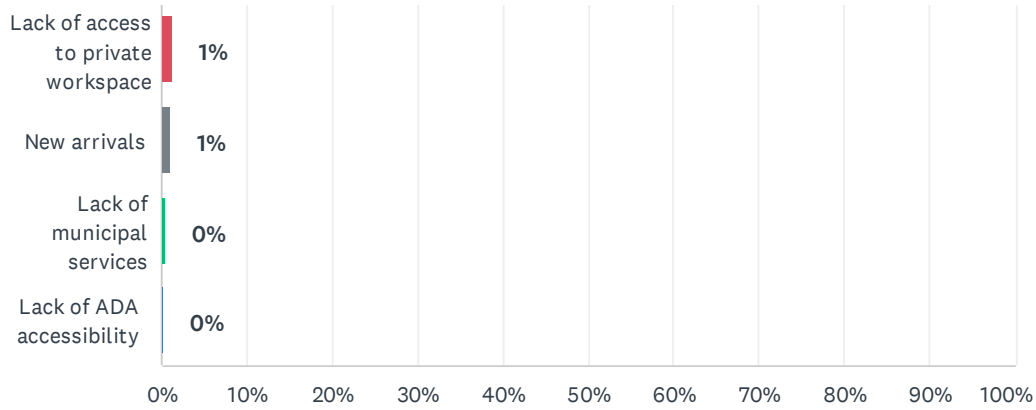


# Q12 What are the biggest problems facing your community today? (Please select up to three)

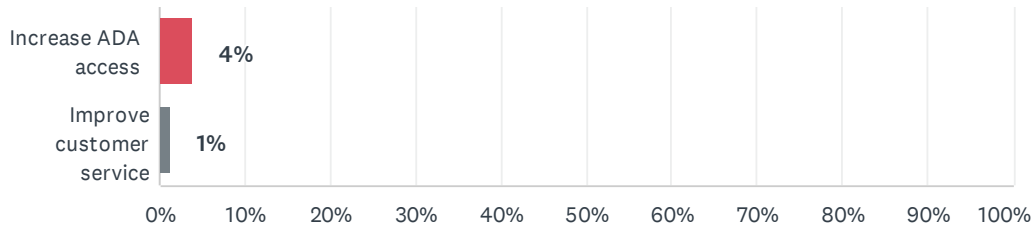
